In 2018 he started a new team “Interoperability” to enable real time data exchange between payor and provider organization utilizing standards being established by HL7 under Da Vinci project. This team has piloted all the implementation guides released and gone thru the ballot process by HL7 and in early 2020 with a few providers in FL state have enabled real time bi-directional exchange of data. Interoperability team also focuses on use cases to provide member data directly to them via handheld device-based applications and/or portals and have enabled IOT (Internet of Things) based real time patient monitoring using.
