From AHIMA E-ALERT

On February 9, the US Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions (HELP) approved the Improving Health Information Technology Act. The legislation creates a star-rating system for electronic health records based on security, usability, and interoperability. The bill also provides the Office of the Inspector General with the authority to investigate and deter information-blocking practices and directs the Government Accountability Office to conduct a study to review methods for securely matching patient records to the correct patient. The bill is part of a larger package concerning biomedical innovation that the committee hopes to advance this Congress.
