Passing the CPHIMS/CAHIMS examination demonstrates mastery of a well-defined body of knowledge considered important to competent practice in today's healthcare information and management systems field. Requirements

CPHIMS requirements:

•Baccalaureate degree plus five (5) years of associated information and management systems experience*, three (3) of those years in healthcare

OR

•Graduate degree plus three (3) years of associated information and management systems experience*, two (2) of those years in healthcare.

CAHIMS requirements:

The CAHIMS is designed for emerging professionals within the industry (five years or less of experience). This certification demonstrates knowledge of health IT and management systems, facilitating entry-level careers in health IT. It is designed to be a career pathway to the CPHIMS credential. To qualify to take the CAHIMS examination and earn CAHIMS certification, you **must** have earned a high school diploma or its equivalent.
