# News From Around the State

Louisiana Tech University's Master of Health Informatics (MHI) program, housed in the College of Applied and Natural Sciences' <u>Department of Health Informatics</u> <u>and Information Management</u>, has been awarded initial accreditation following a rigorous review from the Commission on Accreditation for Health Information Management Education (CAHIIM).

The program met the requirements of a thorough and highly-detailed peer evaluation and site visit that was conducted in the fall of 2013 by the Commission's Panel of Accreditation Reviewers. The CAHIIM's awarding of initial accreditation is recognition of Tech's significant compliance with the commissions' nationally established standards.
